Instructions:

- 1. Think about your resident's behaviors and mood in the past 2 weeks (or 14 days)
- 2. For Little Interest or Pleasure, please circle the score that best describes how often the resident's does not find activities enjoyable, going left to right. (Ex: If they are not enjoying activities early every day, circle +3.)
- 3. For Feeling Down, please circle the score that best describes how often the resident's feels down, going left to right. (Ex: If they feeling down more than half the days, circle +2.)
- 4. Add up the circled scores from "Little Interest or Pleasure" + "Feeling Down"

The lowest possible score is 0, the highest possible score is 6.

A score of 3 and higher indicates that major depression is likely and should be followed up with a more detailed assessment. (Ex: in this example, 3+2=5, and this resident is likely ver/y depressed)
